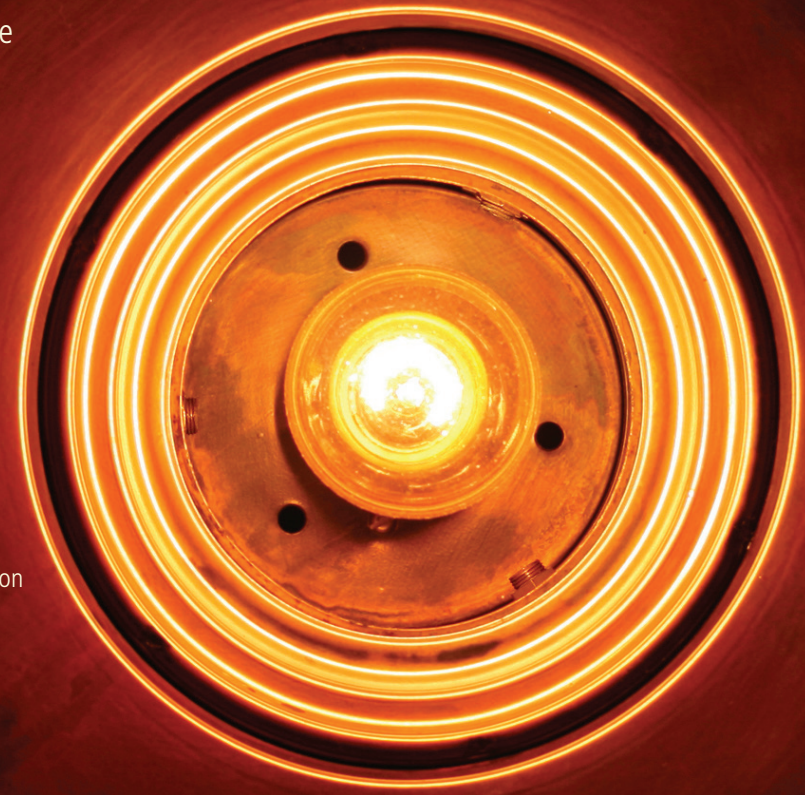

## Who's who in the Ten Lamps Group

### What is the 10 Lamps Group?

10 Lamps is a group of 10 villages:

Camerton, Dunkerton, Farrington Gurney, Foxcote and Shoscombe, High Littleton, Paulton, Peasedown St John, Priston, Timsbury, Wellow: Whose Anglican and Methodist churches have agreed to work together to develop and maintain thriving Christian communities in all 10 villages.

### How does the 10 Lamps Group work?

On the third Sunday of every month the group comes together to worship;

Every Tuesday the group clergy meet to pray and discuss matters concerning the whole group;

The group clergy 'pulpit swap' three times a year;

Members of all the churches are encouraged to see the group clergy as 'theirs';

Three times a year representatives from the groups churches meet to discuss matters concerning the whole group;

Wherever possible the group co-ordinates Lent, Alpha and Emmaus courses, study groups, marriage and confirmation preparation.

### How does the 10 Lamps group benefit us?

By working together and pooling resources individual churches in the group are able to:

- Share burdens with those around them
- Access all the group clergy
- Access group run courses
- Offer a greater variety of worship
- Get to know other Christians in our local area
